Today's headlines suggest that our economy is on "life support" and that it will take a small miracle to avert a full-fledged recession or worse. From my perspective, this cloudy U.S. economic downturn is producing a multi-billion silver-lining for SDVOSB (Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business).

First, I am always being asked, why is our stock trading at \$0.05 cents, or why is it \$0.11 cents? The questions is "What makes our stock go up one day, and down the next?" Why is it that when you put out a news release the stock goes down? Why isn't our stock trading at \$0.50 cents, or a \$1.00, or \$2.00? The simple answer to all the above, is, I don't know. Please hang with me for a minute while I make my existential business case.

Federal, State, City, and County contracts that are associated with the country's core functional needs to represent a safe/dependable revenue source in an unstable market. HUNTINGTON BEACH, Calif.--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Bio-Clean International, Inc. (Pink Sheets: BCLE - News) announced today that its affiliated entity, American Bio-Clean Corporation (ABC), has fulfilled a shipment of weapons cleaning solution for the Defense Logistics Agency.

The Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) supplies the nation's military services and several civilian agencies with the critical resources they need to accomplish their worldwide missions. DLA provides wide-ranging logistical support for peacetime and wartime operations, as well as emergency preparedness and humanitarian missions. Any one using federal funds is required to use their best efforts to locate and offer the opportunity to bid on the project involved, using an SDVOB company as long as the SDVOB company can provide the necessary service, materials, and/or training required by the contract to be bid.

(Pink Sheets: BCLE - News) (www.bio-cleanintl.com) announced today that its subsidiary entities, American Bio-Tech Cleaning, Inc. and American Bio-Clean Corporation, have successfully completed an outstanding order by shipping the last of the equipment cleaning units and special fluids used to clean Teflon grease from aircraft parts. American Bio-Clean is one of the very few companies to have perfected this very special cleaning process to achieve results in difficult grease removal from propellers on C-130J Super Hercules aircraft.

This is the third completed order of the Company's reliable parts cleaning equipment that has been shipped in support of the C-130J program. The Company anticipates receiving additional orders in the current calendar year.

The C-130J Super Hercules is the only airlifter with the range and flexibility for emerging theaters and evolving concepts of operation. This tactical transport aircraft has already proven itself in many kinds of missions, many in the harshest operating conditions possible. In addition, VTC provides training programs for the private sector such as the OSHA safety-training programs for the construction industry and specialized training for civilian and military requirements.

Bio-Clean International also owns a minority interest in **Veterans Asset Management Corporation** (VAM) another certified SDVOB, based in Southern California. VAM is a newly-formed corporation that will be providing a variety of financial services to a wide range of companies and governmental agencies, as well as individuals.
